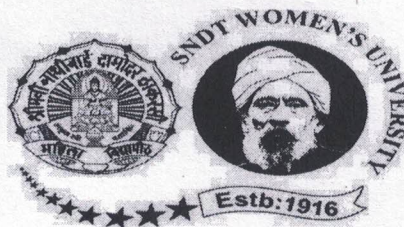

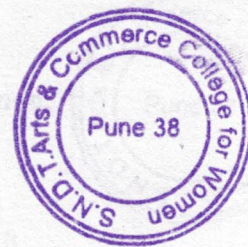

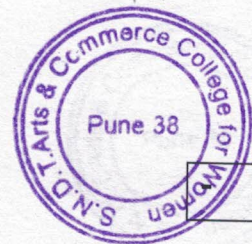

- v) In the research project domain other than UGC e.g. ICSSR, DST, CSIR, INSA, MOE, ISRO should consider for receiving grants for projects, seminar, workshops etc.

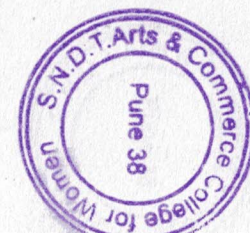
