The SNDT Arts and Commerce College for Women was founded by Bharatratna Maharshi Dhondo Keshav Karve on 5th July 1916, with five students. It is this college at Pune, with which he started the functioning of the Indian Women's University.

This college is thus the very first institution of the university. Today, it functions as a conducted college, owned and governed by the SNDT Women's University, Mumbai. Both the college as well as the university came to be named after Shreemati Nathibai Damodar Thackersey, mother of Sir Vitthaldas Thackersey, who generously donated in the year 1920 for girl's education.

We focus on rigorous quality and delivery of education and aims at strengthening and focusing on research in the areas of social cause and extension activities. This is a brief report of quality enhancement initiatives of the IQAC in the academic year 2015-16.

Other Quality Initiatives

Formation of Anti-Ragging Committee

The College formed Anti-Ragging Committee and Suggestion Boxes scheme for students. A talk on Anti Ragging Act and Dos and Don'ts was organized for the students

Health check-up of all staff members

The health check-up of every permanent and temporary staff member was done in collaboration with Apollo Hospital.

Introduction of fully automated result system

IQAC recommended use of Fully Automated Result System for First Year Examinations for timely declaration of results with highest accuracy. The data entry of marks, both internal and semester examinations is done by the teachers in MS Excel. These data are linked for ledger posting and mark-sheets printing.

Installation of UniSuit Financial System Software

To maintain Uniformity in accounting and Transparency in transactions IQAC suggested use of Accounting Software. Centralised UniSuit Financial System software package was installed. It is a software package for centralized accounting which indicates receipts and payments to the head office every day basis. Record of each receipt and payment is kept digitally recorded.
