This college is thus the very first institution of the university. Today, it functions as a conducted college, owned and governed by the SNDT Women's University, Mumbai. Both the college as well as the university came to be named after Shreemati Nathibai Damodar Thackersey, mother of Sir Vitthaldas Thackersey, who generously donated in the year 1920 for girl's education.

We focus on rigorous quality and delivery of education and aims at strengthening and focusing on research in the areas of social cause and extension activities. This is a brief report of quality enhancement initiatives of the IQAC in the academic year 2017-18.

FDP on use of ICT and Innovative Teaching Methods



Skills Enhancement of Students

Add-on Courses

Brain-Gym: A course based on Yoga and Meditation

An Add-on Course titled "Brain Gymnasium", based on Yoga and Meditation was conducted for teaching faculty, administrative faculty and students. It was a 45 session's programme from26th July 2016 to 11th April 2017. The sessions were arranged in two days per week. 16 teaching staff, 2 administrative staff and 33 students were enrolled for the course. This activity was very fruitful for "Overall Development of Mind and Body". Along with demonstrations the explanation with scientific background by the trainer helped the participants to understand importance of different Yoga Mudras. The course covered techniques from Omkar to Shavasana for flexibility of body and control on breathing. Along with meditation, sharing on Good Habits, Challenging Oneself, Attitude of Gratitude, Socialization were helpful for Self Development and for Being Human.

Certificate Course in Law relating to Rights of Women

Certificate course in "Law relating to Rights of Women" was organised for B. Com students from 5th February 2018 to 14th February 2018. Dr. Advocate Pratapsinh Salunke was the resource person for this 10 hours/seven Day short course. 75 students benefited from this course.

GST as a career Opportunity

GST as a Career Opportunity" was a value added course organised in collaboration with Hope Career Academy from 4th to 19th February 2018. 63 students benefited from this 30 day programme

Entrepreneurship Awareness Programme

A three day (15 hours) add-on-course 'Entrepreneurship Awareness Programme' was organised in collaboration with Maharashtra Centre for Entrepreneurship Development (MCED, GoM), on 19th, 21st and 22nd December 2017. 111 students participated in this programme. Various women entrepreneurs shared their experiences and discussed entrepreneurship as a career option with the students. Three students of this College took inspiration from the programme and prepared perfumes and sold around 200 bottles to customers at reasonable prices in less than two months. 
Soft Skill Development
