





Vision

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About the University

SNDT Women's University is the first Women's university in India as well as in South-East Asia. The University was founded by Maharshi Dr. Dhondo Keshav Karve in 1916 for a noble cause of Women's Education. The first five women graduated in 1921 from this University. The University Headquarters is in Churchgate Campus, Mumbai and the other two campuses of this University are at Juhu, Mumbai and Karve Road, Pune.

In a century old existence, the university has grown into a multidisciplinary institution hosting diverse professional, technical and liberal arts programmes from K12 to PhD. SNDTWU is probably one such university where there is Nursery school as laboratory for Human Development Department, Centres for Women's Studies, Inclusion and Exclusion, Distance Education, andhas affiliated institutions for doctoral programmes. Unlike most university's in the country which have to have state jurisdiction, SNDTWU is unique in terms of jurisdiction. SNDTWU can affiliate colleges/institutions anywhere in India with prior consent from the State Government.

SNDT Women's University is committed to the cause of women's empowerment through access to education, particularly higher education, through relevant courses in the formal and non-formal streams. The university is committed to meet the changing socio-economic needs, with human values and purposeful social responsibility and to achieve excellence with "Quality in every Activity" through vocational and professional courses for women. The motto of the university is "An enlightened woman is a source of infinite strength". There are six institutions recognized by SNDTWU for Ph. D. Research. SNDTWU is a home to 1100 teaching and non-teaching staff members and 50,000 students spread across seven states and a union territory.

SNDT Women's University stands 32nd amongst multi-disciplinary universities of India and ranked fourth in Western India according to the Week-Hansa Research ranking of 2020.

About the College


The SNDT Women's University is established in 1916 by **Bharatratna Maharshi Dr. Dhondo Keshav Karve and generously supported by Sir Vitthaldas Thackersey.** It is the first of its kind in India, imparting education exclusively to women, to suit their aspirations in the fast changing world. It got a statutory recognition in 1951; and thus, became at par with any other university in India. It has been striving for the betterment and empowerment of women from all social strata throughout Maharashtra and Gujarat, through comprehensive and all round progress in education. In 2000, this is the first University getting a high ranking ('A' grade) in accreditation in Maharashtra and the second University in India, voluntarily applying for the evaluation through NAAC and passing the golden test with flying colors. Today, SNDT Women's University has A Grade in NAAC Accreditation.

The SNDT Arts and Commerce College is the premier college of the University situated at Karve Road, Pune. This College offers various courses in Arts, Commerce, Fine Arts (Music, Visual Arts), Computer Applications and Accountancy & Finance for graduation. The College has always remained centre of attraction for the students from all over India. Renowned faculty, personal attention to students, updated and challenging syllabus, hostel facility, well equipped library, sports facilities are some of the special features of the College.

Admission Rules

SNDT Arts and Commerce College for Women is the constituent college of SNDT Women's University and so the College has to abide the guidelines issued by the Government and University circulars issued from time to time. Considering the circulars received so far the admission committee has decided the following policy for admission of the new students in the next year 2025-26.

- 1. Admissions will be given strictly on the basis of merit in the previous year
- 2. While admitting the students reservations for different categories will be considered. The College will follow the chart showing seats available category wise.
- 3. As per the circular 15% seats will be available for admission through management quota.
- 4. Admission Process and Flow Chart will be made available to students seeking admission through web site. For convenience hard copies will be displayed in the College office.

Centralized University Library

A centralized library and departmental library is available in the Campus. The students have to pay library registration fees with the admission fee and have to get the membership of the library. The Library provides students with:

Well-equipped computer lab with internet facility and up dated soft-wares is available. The students get free access to computers with internet.

Student Learning and Development

Studying in the College is a stimulating, challenging and rewarding experience. In order to make the most of this experience, the College provides a wide range of resources and services to support and enhance your academic development in different areas. The following activities help you develop the skills and abilities you need in order to succeed in your studies and to enhance your abilities.

✓ Sports Department:

To promote the sporting spirit and to motivate students to participate in sports and games, training in the sports like Kho-Kho, Kabaddi, and Volleyball etc. is arranged in the College. Expert coaches are appointed for this purpose. Students can participate in different sports at University and National level. Special coaching is imparted for individual as well as team sports. In gym multi-functions machines like trade mill, crossover, and cycles are available. Timings of gym are from 8 a.m. to 12.30 p.m. and 1p.m. to 5.30 p.m.

✓ N.C.C.:

The College has a separate N.C.C. Unit attached to 2 Maharashtra Girls Battalion. It is managed by an associate officer (ANO).

✓ N.S.S.:

As per the guidelines and the orders of government, the College has the department of N.S.S. Students can participate in different National and Social awareness programmes. This department arranges visits to social institutions; and also, arranges lectures-cum-discussions on different social problems and issues with a view to creating social awareness among the students. A special residential winter camp is organized every year.

✓ Cultural Activities:

With a view to developing all round personality of the students, this department organizes competitions for theatre events, literary events, as well as for drawing, music and dance competitions.

✓ Shabdotsav (Annual college magazine):

Students write articles on current topics and current events in the College magazine 'Shabdotsav', which manifests their understanding of these issues.

Learn New Skills (Add-On Courses)

- ✓ Swayam The students can enhance their career prospects by undergoing one or more add-on courses offered in the College along with their studies for the degree programme. The students are expected to complete at least two add-on courses during their three-year academic programme in the College. The announcements of the courses will be done in the months of July and October every year. The students need to enroll themselves for these courses as per their need and liking. After completing the course successfully the student will be awarded a Certificate with appropriate credits. The students are expected to visit https://swayam.gov.in/ for free on-line MOOC Courses offered by Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD).
- ✓ Centre for Holistic Education, Training and Novel Advancements (CHETNA) The Centre for Holistic Education, Training and Novel Advancements (SNDTWU-CHETNA) is a center established by SNDTWU to develop and create a pool of need-based, Value-based, skill-based capacity-building add-on courses in collaboration with local, national, and international institutions. It will provide courses and programs to build character through human and constitutional values also, develop life skills, employability skills, and 21st-century skills that are required for betterment of the society, environment and the whole ecosystem. The center aims to act as a bridge between our past; the culture and the technological and social advancements in the future by introducing programs based on our culture and heritage for a sustainable future. The center aims to provide an environment to enhance the creativity of students by providing novel and unusual programs. The name 'SNDTWU-CHETNA' means 'Consciousness' which is the very essence of life.

Hostel Facilities

Students from outside Pune can avail themselves the hostel accommodation on merit basis. The student has to pay accommodation and mess charges at subsidized rates. Medical facility is also available. Hostel has its own rules and regulations for maintaining discipline in the hostel as per the University guidelines. Code of conduct

DISCIPLINE

The student must observe and strictly follow the disciplinary rules and regulations of the College.

The student should follow the academic calendar as per the instructions of Head of the Departments

Any act of indiscipline or misbehavior by any student will attract severe punishment.

Damage to Institute & campus property due to negligence/lack of care would attract punishment and compensation for loss caused.

Students shall only use the waste bins for disposing waste materials in classrooms, hostels and offices to make the college campus free from plastic and other litter.

Students have to park their vehicles in parking zone only. Any student found breaking the rule will be punished.

No person shall be invited to address or entertain the students of the college, without the prior written permission of college authorities.

Students are prohibited from indulging in anti-institutional, anti-national, antisocial, communal, immoral or political expressions and activities within the Campus and hostels. Disciplinary action will be initiated against students indulging into ragging, harassment, bullying and untoward incidents.

All Educational tours or Industrial visits shall be accompanied by the faculty members after obtaining necessary undertaking from the Parents of the students and with the written consent of the management.

Unauthorized entry of outsiders into the campus as well as hostels is strictly prohibited. Any case of criminal activity or violation of law and order in the College Campus will be reported to the police.

I-CARD

Every student must carry with her college I-card every day while attending lectures and appearing for various examinations. The student should take her Identity Card and Library Card for Home Lending, from the Library at the beginning of the year. The student should carry identity card with her regularly and the identity card should be produced when demanded by the authorized persons of the College If student has lost library card or I-

card, it should be reported immediately to the HOD and the librarian with an application.

MOBILE PHONE

The student should switch off their mobile phones while in the classroom, Laboratory, Library etc. as per notification.

Mobile phone is strictly prohibited in the exam hall during the examination.

Loss or theft of mobiles, modern means of communications, valuables and other belongings are at students' risk.

RAGGING

Ragging, as per the Directions of Hon'ble Supreme court of India, and THE MAHARASHTRA PROHIBITION OF RAGGING ACT, 1999, As modified from time to time, is strictly prohibited in the College; and, will result in cancellation of admission and also the student will be debarred from taking admission in any institution in India. It may result in suspension from attending classes; or withholding/Withdrawing scholarship / fellowship and other benefits or debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process or Withholding results or debarring from representing the College in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival etc., or suspension / expulsion from the institution; or collective punishment if larger number of students are involved in the act of ragging; or an FIR filed without any exception with local police station.

ATTENDANCE

Student should be regular in attendance for all sessions during the working days.

Student should have at least 75% attendance in the Lectures of every subject; and, if the student is found irregular in attendance, disciplinary action will be taken.

On no account will students be allowed to remain absent for any internal and semester examination conducted by the College or continuous assessment conducted by faculty in classes. The student will be entirely responsible for such absence. This may be detrimental to the overall performance and results of the student.

The student should complete the entire Practical and Term – work such as Journals, Assignments and Projects in the stipulated time.

EXAMINATION

Candidates must appear at the examination hall half an hour before the commencement

of the examination.

Mobile phone is strictly prohibited in the examination hall during the examination.

Candidates should not communicate, transfer and pass on any cheating / copy / writing material to one another in any manner during the examination.

A candidate is permitted to bring the following items to an exam: pen, pencil, and, if specifically permitted, non-programmable calculators. All equipment brought to the examination must be placed on the candidate's desk and kept in view during the examination.

• DISSERTATIONS AND INTERNSHIPS

Students are instructed to follow the information and guidelines given by the guide from time to time and make the timely submission of their projects completed in all respect.
