

The SNDT Arts and Commerce College for Women was founded by Bharatratna Maharshi Dhondo Keshav Karve on 5th July 1916, with five students. It is this college at Pune, with which he started the functioning of the Indian Women's University.

This college is thus the very first institution of the university. Today, it functions as a conducted college, owned and governed by the SNDT Women's University, Mumbai. Both the college as well as the university came to be named after Shreemati Nathibai Damodar Thackersey, mother of Sir Vitthaldas Thackersey, who generously donated in the year 1920 for girl's education.

Extensive use of ICT tools for teaching, learning and Evaluation:



For Internal Evaluation, blended system was adopted during the year.




Use of ICT in Teaching

Gender Sanitization:

The College is perceptive towards gender equity, gender sensitization through various curricular and extra- curricular activities. The foundation course 'Status of women in a changing India' was directly focus on gender equity, gender sensitization. Reading Club and ICC committee arrange various programme related this subject.

Waste Management

The college has a solid waste management system. On the Premises and in the classrooms, separate bins are kept for the Collection of solid waste. College sells the waste papers to the vendor who makes the paper pulp. The vendor provides the certificate mentioning the recycling system of the purchased stuff from the college. In the office, maximum utilization of paper is taken care of by recycling or by reusing both sides of the paper. The tube lights and LED lights that are not working are separated at the college level and then handed over to the Pune Municipal Corporation for disposal. The Hostel Mess segregates the wet and dry food waste in different bins and hands over it to the Pune Municipal Corporation. For solid waste disposal like books, the library keeps those books for sale, free of cost in an activity conducted by the Library as Pickup Me.

Extension Activities

On 25th March 2022, NSS Unit of the College Organizes Workshop on "PINK POUCHES MAKING" at SNDT College of education for Women, Pune. Total beneficiaries for the programme were 163. This program is benefited to the students in terms of their health and protection of environment.
