# 18th January to 24nd January, 2024

# The Special Residential Camp was organized with the following objectives in connection with the theme 'An Enlightened Women is a Source of Infinite Strength':

- Team-Building.
- Understanding and problem-solving of the people in rural-urban area.
- Personality development of the students.
- To create awareness in the community about the social problems.
- To gain practical knowledge of working in community.
- To create awareness for water management, road safety, cleanliness and hygiene.
- To create awareness for women empowerment, superstitions, financial inclusion and cashless economy among people in adopted village.

#### **Preparation for the Special Residential Camp:**

- One hundred forty-one NSS Volunteers were selected for the camp. They were divided into Fourteen groups to share various responsibilities such as cooking, maintaining discipline and cleanliness, organizing cultural activities and interaction with the resource persons and the visit to the villagers and the school authorities at Phulgaon.
- In consultation with the villagers, activities such as Shramadan, Tree-plantation, Street Play, communication with the people and students in village, rally for awareness, organising guest lectures. etc. were planned.
